Contractor's Organization Recognizes Two Legislators With Appreciation Award

On December 10th, State Representatives Candace Bouchard and David Campbell were recognized with an Appreciation Award from the Associated General Contractors of New Hampshire (AGC of NH), during the Association's Annual Meeting.

Representatives Bouchard and Campbell of the House Public Works and Highways Committee were recognized for their extraordinary efforts in bringing transportation issues to the forefront.
